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Sleeping at a friend's – Early Literacy Skills

ACTIVITY 1: SLEEP OVER PARTY

Objectives/ aims of activity (children will be able to):

- Discover different letters
- Appreciate and enjoy coming into first contact with letters

Activity steps

1. Preparation: the teacher puts up many letters (printed out on a piece of paper) in a sports room (it should be an empty room with no barriers).
2. The children enter the darkened sports room. One child has a flashlight and looks on the wall for one letter, sets the flashlight on the letter, and says out loud which letter he/she has found (maybe with the help of the teacher).
3. The next child looks for the next letter.

Resources needed to carry out the activity

- Flashlights
- Letters (cut out or written on paper)
