Sleeping at a friend's – Language awareness

ACTIVITY 3: WHAT'S THIS STORY ABOUT?

Objectives/ aims of activity (children will be able to):

- interpret the meaning of a story using non-verbal and verbal cues in L2/FL
- understand that it is fine if they don't understand (everything in) L2/FL and that they can rely on non-verbal clues to compose meaning

Activity steps

- 1) The teacher first introduces the story in a language that the children don't understand (well). It could be through dialogic reading or by using the video and audio recordings on the platform.
- 2) The teacher asks the children to interpret/retell the story in their L1, using illustrations. What do they think the story is about? What happened first? Etc.

Resources needed to carry out the activity

- audio recordings of the story

Approximate time indication for activity: 15 minutes
