





Sleeping at a friend's - Plurilingual competence

ACTIVITY 3: MOVE AND SPEAK ALONG

Objectives/ aims of activity (children will be able to):

Follow and act out an action story

Activity steps (based on the story)

1) The teacher can be the narrator and mime and encourage children to join in

Narrator: Come with me, to my house. Let's go!

All the children (wave, smile, move): Come with me, to my house!

Narrator: Here's the sword, here's the horse. We are knights!

All children (pretend to fight): Here's the sword, here's the horse. We are knights!

Narrator: I want bread, I want more. Enjoy your meal.

All children (pretend to eat and drink): want bread, I want more. Enjoy your meal.

Narrator: Clean your teeth, clean your face, tidy up.

All children (make a mess, brush teeth, clean up): Clean your teeth, clean your face, tidy up.

Narrator: I am tired, what a day! Let's sleep.

All children (close eyes, pretend to sleep or snore): I am tired, what a day! Let's sleep.

- 2) With each telling, the children can speak more
- 3) The teacher and later children can call out the sentences and children mime. This can be a whole class or group activity
