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Celebrating Olivia's birthday - Plurilingual competence

ACTIVITY 2: BIRTHDAY WISHES

Objectives/ aims of activity (children will be able to):

- Understand and try to say some typical words/expressions used when celebrating a birthday (e.g., birthday cake, to sing, to eat, to congratulate)

Activity steps

- 1) Children record either typical words/expressions or their birthday experience.
- 2) Children listen to each other's words/expressions (whether recorded or not), learn to understand these expressions and use them in a meaningful way.
- 3) Guessing games
 - The adult/ children show objects or picture cards and children label them
 - A child describes the object, another draws
 - Kim games (touching)

Resources needed to carry out the activity

- Resources for recording: children can use a phone or an app (e.g., iTEO, Book creator)
- Resources "Saying Happy birthday in different languages": story7_PL_2_Res
- Learning other words/expressions used when celebrating a birthday (e.g., birthday cake, to sing, to eat, to congratulate)
- Examples of different recorded words/expressions (e.g., QR code, little booklet)
