





Going home - Intercultural awareness and understanding

ACTIVITY 1: LIVING AROUND THE WORLD

Objectives/ aims of activity (children will be able to):

- Discover that children around the world live in many different types of homes
- Foster respect and curiosity for different ways of living
- Get to know and reflect on different traditions and rituals ways to say goodbye

Activity steps

- 1) Children build (what they imagine could be) Bobba's house with different materials (e.g. construction toys, modelling clay)
- 2) The teacher engages children in a conversation about the differences of their constructions (e.g. colours, shape, size)
- 3) Make a movement game Living in different homes: for each photo, children invent gestures/movements (e.g. skyscraper – stand up tall on tiptoes; round house – make a round shape with the arms); the teacher takes a photo of each gesture

Resources needed to carry out the activity

- Pictures of different types of homes: Story5_ICAU_3_Res
- Materials to build Bobba's house (e.g. construction toys, modeling clay)

Approximative time indication for activity

- Building Bobba's house (30 minutes)
- Talk about the differences (15 minutes)
- Showing pictures about different types of homes (10 minutes)
- The game can last 10 minutes
