



Going Home – Plurilingual Competence

ACTIVITY 1: CELEBRATING BOBBA'S FAREWELL

Objectives/ Aims of activity (children will be able to)

- Celebrate farewells.
- Sing a song in order to create a joyful atmosphere of togetherness and music for celebrating good-byes in many languages. Song at: https://suno.com/s/Wx7sJlm0ASIVfdq5

Activity steps

- 1) The teacher plays the song and invites the children to move along and dance together. Alternatively, they can create their own plurilingual goodbye-song using Al apps such as www.sunoai.ai.
- 2) The teacher motivates children to move in a song train through the classroom.
- 3) The teacher encourages children to sing along to the plurilingual goodbye song.

Resources needed to carry out the activity
